PURPOSE:

The purpose of the **Photo Group Photo Shows** is to share our club member's best photos on the computer LCD projector, while members learn how to take better pictures based on the **Educational Critique Team's** suggestions and comments.

PHOTO SHOWS: Similar in format, with a different focus.

1. The **Open Photo Show** – featuring 1-5 pictures each from many Photo Group *members*. Pictures can be color, black & white, new or old, as long as they are in good taste for public viewing. Suggestions and comments provided by the **Educational Critique Team**.
2. The **Field Trip Photo Show** – Photo Group *members* who participated in a recent Photo Group field trip should send **up to 5 photos** via email to the **Education Chair** in **advance**. Suggestions and comments provided from the **Educational Critique Team**.
3. The **One-Man or One-Woman Show** – 20 of a Photo Group *member's* best pictures, with brief comments by the photographer and immediate suggestions and comments provided from the **Educational Critique Team**.
4. The **Traveling Photographer Series** - a Photo Group *member's* best 20 pictures from an exotic location, with brief comments by the photographer and immediate suggestions and comments provided by the **Educational Critique Team**.

PRESENTATION FORMAT:

- ✓ Organized, prepared and submitted in advance for an effective presentation
- ✓ Moderated by the **Education Chair**
- ✓ Brief comments by the photographer
- ✓ Immediate discussion by the **Educational Critique Team**

CRITIQUE:

The **Educational Critique Team** will provide constructive comments and criticism of the photos with the intent of helping all members understand how to take better photographs.

The photographs will be evaluated on the following:

- ✓ Impact
- ✓ Composition & Lighting
- ✓ Creativity
- ✓ Artistic Skill
- ✓ Technical Quality
- ✓ Areas for Improvement
