Our **WEB SITE** will bring you all of our latest information on offerings and meetings as well as portions of our newsletter. Our URL is:

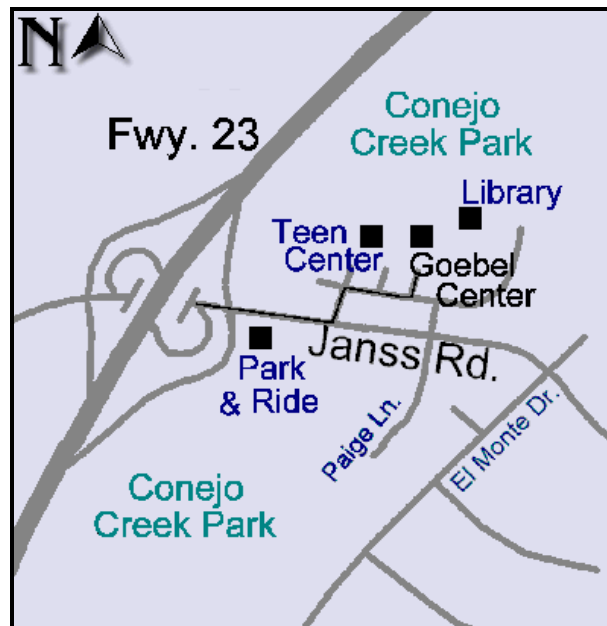
